Opening an Account

To join, you will need to call to one of Black Raven Credit Union Service Centres. You will need three forms of identification, one from each of these three sections.

- 1. Evidence of Identification (must have date of birth and recent photo)
 - Current valid Passport
 - Current valid Driving Licence
- 2. Evidence of Address (must show your name & current address and be dated within the last 3 months)
 - Original Recent Utility Bill
 - Original Recent Bank/Credit Card Statement
 - Government Correspondence
- 3. Evidence of your PPS number
 - P60
 - Payslip
 - Any revenue documentation

Due to legislative developments Credit Unions are unable to accept the Public Service Card (PSC) as a form of identification, or of PPSN confirmation going forward.

Currently, a body that is not explicitly specified in the main Social Welfare Act is prohibited from accepting the PSC as proof of identity or PPSN, even where the cardholder voluntarily tenders it for this purpose.

There is a €1 joining fee which is deducted from your first lodgement to the account.
